

“Frame 2026” course information

Please read carefully

- All CF courses are priced to break even so to keep costs low we require a minimum number of participants. Course students pay a deposit to join a course and they will be notified when the balance will become due.
If some unforeseen issue the course cannot go ahead then the you will be notified and the deposit will be fully refunded immediately.
- All courses are fully insured under the Carpenters Fellowship’s insurance. To qualify all students will need to register as a member of the CF if not already.
- All students will camp on site or travel from home. Camper vans are allowed but there are no hook ups, disabled access is provided.
- All meals are provided for the duration of the course; students must note any dietary requirements on the application form. Students can opt to stay on for the full Frame weekend by prepaying for just their meals.
- Courses will typically start each day at 8.00am with breakfast and break for lunch with a hot evening meal at the end of the day. You can arrive the night before if you wish.
- The Earth Trust is an operational sheep farm and as such **dogs are not allowed on courses or off leash at any time during the Frame weekend.**
- A limited number of concessionary course fees are available for those on low income, please note on your application form and we will come back to you.

Evenings

- **A limited bar** will be available with beer, cider and soft drinks and a chiller is available.
 - Card payments are preferred.
- **Entertainment:** Bring any instruments or with you as there will be several courses going on so there will be a lot of similarly minded people looking to be entertained in the evenings.
- **Showers:** arrangements have been made for participants to shower at the local sports centre 8 minutes away. The cost is included in the course but students will need to arrange their own transport.
